CANCELLATION OF ALL PUBLIC WORSHIP AND TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHURCH

There is new guidance from the Director of Health and Care for Staffordshire. Places of worship in Shobnall, Anglesey, Horninglow and Eton Park have received additional, enhanced guidance on Covid 19 following an increase in the number of cases in these areas. S. John's is closed again for public worship and private prayer.

Please note there will be **NO SERVICE ON WEDNESDAY 16 SEPTEMBER** and church will be closed. If the guidance changes, every effort will be made to contact people who might wish to come. Sunday services will continue to be broadcast live at 10 am at facebook.com/stjohnshorninglow

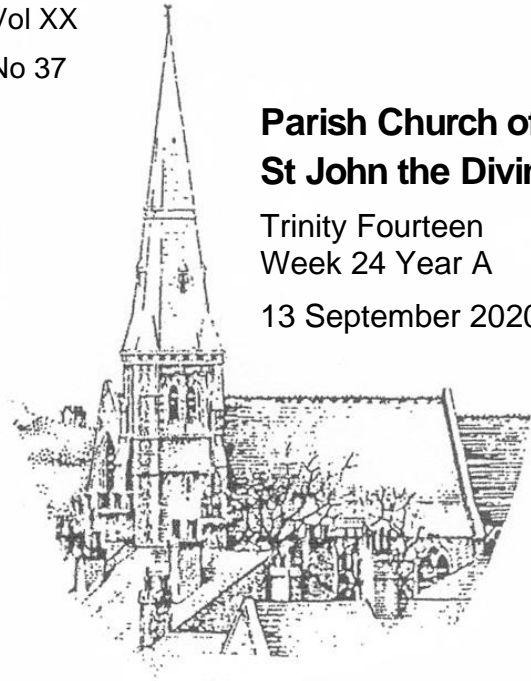
