Horninglow Church.

The first Turf was dug by John Hopkins, Nov. 21st, 1864. The first Stone was Laid by Mrs. Hopkins Dec. 27th, 1864.

Joseph Perceful fell from the Church Spire which was about 90 feet high, he was not killed and is now prittey well again.

October 28, 1865, finished the Spire and Mr. Elliott put on the Weathercock.

The first peal of the new Bells were Rang by the Rollestone Ringers June 29th, 1866.

Poor Mr. Elliott died July 17th, 1866, Aged 58

St. John's Church, Horninglow, Consecratied October 24/1866, and on Sunday, 29, the Rev. John Auden preached is first sermon to a Crowded Congration and adminested the Sacriment, the first Funeral at 2 o'clock, 5 Baptisems and a Churching.

July 23rd, 1867, the first Marriages were Solomonised by the Rev. T. Auden, M.A., Mr. Henry Crofts to Mifs Walters, at the same time Mr. Wm. Walters of the Derby Road to Mifs Dakin. Mrs. Hopkins presented the first Bride with a Bible and Mrs. Malden the other Bride with a Bible.
