

Notice from Staffordshire's Direction of Health and Social Care:

Community Testing:

The key message for residents in the county remains to get tested regularly, at least twice a week.

Local testing options include:

- People can order packs of rapid lateral flow home testing kits online or collect from selected pharmacies.
- Home testing kits are also available at national and community testing centres for collection.
- Walk-in supervised tests are available at our community testing centres and touring pop-ups.

People are allowed to leave home to take a test.

Testing is available at Hillfield House on Hillfield Lane in Stretton, opposite S. Mary's Church, every day this week from 10.00 to 16.00, but check times on the web if possible. No booking is necessary.
