

Notice from Staffordshire's Direction of Health and Social Care:

Cases of Covid-19 are falling in Staffordshire but remain high.

People must not leave or be outside their home except where necessary. However, some people may need to leave home for example to shop for necessities or to go to work, if they cannot work from home.

We are asking all people who do need to leave the house to get tested regularly, even if they have no symptoms.

This is especially important for people who live in [hotspot areas](#).

Staffordshire residents are now able to walk in to one of our community testing sites to get a rapid Covid-19 test. Walk ins are subject to availability at each individual site - to secure a slot, booking on our [community testing sites](#) page is still recommended.

People are allowed to leave home to take a test.

Testing is available at Hillfield House on Hillfield Lane in Stretton, opposite S. Mary's Church, 7 days a week.
